ITEMS PROHIBITED FROM TRASH CANS AND DUMPSTERS

The following items may not be placed in EC trashcans or dumpsters for disposal at a municipal solid waste landfill. If you have questions about other items that may or may not be placed in the trash, please contact Campus Safety for assistance.

ITEM PROHIBITED FROM TRASH	WHERE IT SHOULD GO INSTEAD
Appliances.	Surplus property – contact Facilities.
Asbestos-containing wastes, including transite (hardboard/siding) and other white insulating materials that appear to be asbestos.	Contact Facilities Management.
Batteries – lead acid, Ni-cad, button. *	Return to the vendor from which the new battery is purchased; deliver to local battery recyclers;
Compressed gas cylinders.	Return to the vendor.
Computer and electronic equipment and components. *	Surplus property – contact ITS
Dead wild animals (i.e., birds, squirrels, etc.). *	Contact Facilities.
Latex paint containers containing paint that is not dried. *	Tag for collection by Facilities.
Non-infectious needles and sharps. *	Containerize in rigid, puncture- resistant container, seal, label as "Sharps," place in outside refuse container (e.g., dumpster).

Non-living animals used for research, necropsy, or teaching purposes.	Consult with Yvonne King x 8442 for proper management method based on specific circumstances (available methods of disposal include rendering, management through EC's infectious waste vendor, or incineration).
Office furniture.	Surplus property – contact Facilities.
Oil-based paint, paint chips, and paintbrushes.	Tag for collection by Facilities.
Pesticides, fertilizers and other agricultural chemicals, and empty containers of these items that have not been triple-rinsed or processed in accordance with label directions.	Return to the manufacturer
Petroleum oil.	Tag for collection by Facilities
Propane cylinders.	Return to the vendor.
Red bag waste, including boxes, and other items labeled "Biohazardous," needles and sharps, bloody gauze, bandages, towels, clothes, and other like items. *	Package for collection by Facilities or autoclave with indicator tape, repack or overpack in an unmarked, non-transparent container, and dispose as ordinary refuse.
Thermostats (mercury-containing). See computer and electronic equipment and components for electronic thermostats	Tag for collection by Facilities.
Used and excess chemicals.	Tag for collection by Facilities (unless NAS has granted written permission or has published a fact sheet that states that the material may be disposed otherwise).
Wet wastes, or wastes such as sludges, that contain liquids that could drip or leak from the waste.	Contact Facilities.
