Sheen Auditorium Redsign

The old Sheen auditorium is split into two rooms. One is a traditional auditorium setup similar to GMSL auditorium.

The traditional auditorium has 5 rows with 12 movable chairs per row. Each row is about 42 feet long so that is plenty of space per student. Large demo tables also accentuate the room. This room can be sloped.

A second classroom in studio format is located at the old front entrance. The room would have six large tables (diameter 7 ft, circumference 22 ft) so it can sit 6 or 7 students comfortably. The instructor would actually stand in the center of the room with work being digitized and projected on multiple screens. A storage room is also added to accommodate scientific equipment.
